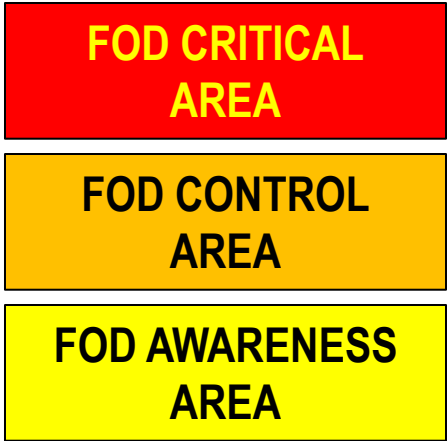




Foreign Object Debris (FOD) is any material or object that has invaded an aircraft, satellite, missile, or assembly. FOD can interfere with the safe operation, sometimes with lethal consequences. At Boeing, we take FOD Prevention very seriously!

No matter where you are at Boeing, controlling everything you bring in, properly disposing of unwanted items, and keeping worksites clean during and after the work is done is an important part of our FOD Prevention program.



In certain areas, additional measures will be required. These areas will be marked. Before going into these marked areas, make sure you meet all the requirements to entry *or are escorted by someone who meets the requirements for entry.*

Escort: Area Designation	Required Training
Unescorted: FOD Critical or FOD Control Areas	Classroom course #76131
Unescorted: FOD Awareness Area	On-line course #75164
Escorted: Any Area	Briefing by escort
