Puget Sound Suspension of Operations Extension

Dear Boeing Supplier,

The health and safety of our teammates is always our top priority. Due to the company's continuous assessment of the situation caused by COVID-19 in Washington state, the reliability of the supply chain, and additional recommendations from government health authorities, Boeing is extending the temporary suspension of operations at all Puget Sound area and Moses Lake sites until further notice. These actions are being taken to ensure the well-being of employees, their families and the local community.

For our suppliers, this means that unless otherwise directed by your authorized procurement agent, you should continue adhering to instructions outlined in letters dated on or around March 24 and holding delivery of parts and services until you receive further communication which will provide shipment delivery requirements and other pertinent information regarding resumption of operations.

During this time, Boeing employees who are able to telecommute from home must continue to do so. We will continue implementing additional health and safety measures to protect all visitors to Boeing sites. Guidance for all non-Boeing personnel visiting Boeing sites is found [here](#).

We will continue to listen to our team, and assess applicable government direction, the spread of the coronavirus in the community, the health of our suppliers and readiness of our facilities to ensure we are ready for a safe, responsible and orderly return to operations.
