CUSTOMER CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

The following customer contract requirements apply to this contract to the extent indicated below. If this contract is for the procurement of commercial items under a Government prime contract, as defined in FAR Part 2.101, see Section 3 below.

1. FAR Clauses The following contract clauses are incorporated by reference from the Federal Acquisition Regulation and apply to the extent indicated. In all of the following clauses, "Contractor" and "Offeror" mean Seller.

52.203-6 Restrictions on Subcontractor Sales to the Government (JUL 1995). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds (i) \$100,000 if included in Buyer's customer RFP or customer contract issued before October 1, 2010 or (ii) \$150,000 if included in Buyer's customer RFP issued on or after October 1, 2010, or if the prime contract was issued prior to October 1, 2010 but was amended after October 1, 2010 to increase the Simplified Acquisition Threshold

52.203-7 Anti-Kickback Procedures (JUL 1995). Buyer may withhold from sums owed Seller the amount of any kickback paid by Seller or its subcontractors at any tier if (a) the Contracting Officer so directs, or (b) the Contracting Officer has offset the amount of such kickback against money owed Buyer under the prime contract. This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$100,000.

52.203-12 Limitation on Payments to Influence Certain Federal Transactions (SEP 2005). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds (i) \$100,000 if included in Buyer's customer RFP or customer contract issued before October 1, 2010 or (ii) \$150,000 if included in Buyer's customer RFP issued on or after October 1, 2010, or if the prime contract was issued prior to October 1, 2010 but was amended after October 1, 2010 to increase the Simplified Acquisition Threshold. Paragraph (c)(4) is modified to read as follows: "(c)(4) Seller will promptly submit any disclosure required (with written notice to Boeing) directly to the PCO for the prime contract. Boeing will identify the cognizant Government PCO at Seller's request. Each subcontractor certification will be retained in the subcontract file of the awarding contractor.

52.203-15 Whistleblower Protections Under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (MAR 2009).

52.204-11 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act--Reporting (MAR 2009). If this contract is in excess of \$25,000, Seller is not an individual, and in the previous tax year, Seller had gross income of \$300,000 or more, Seller shall promptly upon receipt of the contract provide Buyer's Authorized Procurement Representative the information described in subparagraphs (i), (ix), (x), and (xi) of paragraph (d) (10) of FAR 52.204-11. Buyer advises Seller that the information will be made available to the public as required by section 1512 of the Recovery Act.

52.208-8 Required Sources for Helium and Helium Usage Data (APR 2002). This clause only applies if helium is required.

52.209-6 Protecting the Government's Interests When Subcontracting With Contractors Debarred, Suspended or Proposed for Debarment (JAN 2005). Seller agrees it is not debarred, suspended, or proposed for debarment by the Federal Government. Seller shall disclose to Buyer, in writing, whether as of the time of award of this contract, Seller or its principals, is or is not debarred, suspended, or proposed for debarment by the Federal Government.

52.215-2 Audit and Records - Negotiation Alternate I (MAR 2009). This clause applies if this contract is funded in whole or in part with Recovery Act funds. If 52.215-2, with Alternate I applies, 52.215-2, without Alternate I is deleted. This clause applies if this contract exceeds (i) \$100,000 if included in Buyer's customer RFP or customer contract issued before October 1, 2010 or (ii) \$150,000 if included in Buyer's customer RFP issued on or after October 1, 2010, or if the prime contract was issued prior to October 1, 2010 but was amended after October 1, 2010 to increase the Simplified Acquisition Threshold and (iii) is cost-reimbursement, incentive, time-and-materials, labor-hour or price redeterminable type or any combination of these for which cost or pricing data are required or for which Buyer is required to furnish reports to the Government in accordance with paragraph (e) of this clause.

52.215-10 Price Reduction for Defective Cost or Pricing Data (OCT 1997). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds the threshold set forth in FAR 15.403-4 and is not otherwise exempt. In subparagraph (3) of paragraph (a), insert "of this contract" after

"price or cost." In Paragraph (c), "Contracting Officer" shall mean "Contracting Officer or Buyer." In Paragraphs (c)(1), (c)(1)(ii), and (c)(2)(i), "Contracting Officer" shall mean "Contracting Officer or Buyer." In Subparagraph (c)(2)(i)(A), delete "to the Contracting Officer." In Subparagraph (c)(2)(ii)(B), "Government" shall mean "Government or Buyer." In Paragraph (d), "United States" shall mean "United States or Buyer."

52.215-14 Integrity of Unit Prices (OCT 1997). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds (i) \$100,000 if included in Buyer's customer RFP or customer contract issued before October 1, 2010 or (ii) \$150,000 if included in Buyer's customer RFP issued on or after October 1, 2010, or if the prime contract was issued prior to October 1, 2010 but was amended after October 1, 2010 to increase the Simplified Acquisition Threshold. This clause does not apply to construction or architect-engineer services under FAR Part 36; utility services under FAR Part 41; services where supplies are not required; commercial items; and petroleum products.

52.215-15 Pension Adjustments and Asset Reversions (OCT 2004). This clause applies to this contract if it meets the requirements of FAR 15.408(g).

52.215-18 Reversion or Adjustment of Plans for Post-Retirement Benefits (PRB) Other Than Pensions (JUL 2005). This clause applies to this contract if it meets the requirements of FAR 15.408(j).

52.219-9 Small-Business Subcontracting Plan (JUL 2005). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$500,000 and Seller is not a small business concern. Seller shall adopt a subcontracting plan that complies with the requirements of this clause. In addition, Seller shall submit to Buyer Form X31162, Small Business Subcontracting Plan Certificate of Compliance. As required by subparagraph (d)(10)(v), the following information is provided: (1) the prime contract number is 0000111410; (2) Buyer's DUNS number is 008384588, and (3) the email address of Buyer's official responsible for acknowledging receipt of or rejecting ISR reports is (contact Buyer's Authorized Procurement Representative).

52.222-1 Notice to the Government of Labor Disputes (FEB 1997). The terms "Contracting Officer" shall mean Buyer.

52.222-4 Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act-Overtime Compensation (JUL 2005). Buyer may withhold or recover from Seller the amount of any sums the Contracting Officer withholds or recovers from Buyer because of liabilities of Seller or its subcontractors under this clause.

52.222-21 Prohibition of Segregated Facilities (FEB 1999).

52.222-26 Equal Opportunity (APR 2002).

52.222-35 Equal Opportunity for Special Disabled Veterans, Veterans of the Vietnam Era, and Other Eligible Veterans (DEC 2001). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$25,000.

52.222-36 Affirmative Action For Workers With Disabilities (JUN 1998). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$10,000.

52.222-37 Employment Reports on Special Disabled Veterans, Veterans of the Vietnam Era, and Other Eligible Veterans (DEC 2001). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$25,000.

52.222-39 Notification of Employee Rights Concerning Payment of Union Dues or Fees (DEC 2004).

52.222-41 Service Contract Act of 1965 (NOV 2007). This clause applies only if this contract is subject to the Act.

52.222-54 Employment Eligibility Verification (JAN 2009).

This clause applies to all subcontracts that (1) are for (i) commercial or noncommercial services (except for commercial services that are part of the purchase of a COTS item, or an item that would be a COTS item, but for minor modifications performed by the COTS provider and are normally provided for that COTS item), or (ii) construction; (2) has a value of more than \$3,000; and (3) includes work performed in the United States.

52.223-14 Toxic Chemical Release Reporting (AUG 2003). This clause applies only if this contract is not for commercial items as defined in FAR Part 2, was competitively awarded, and exceeds \$100,000 (including all options).

52.224-2 Privacy Act (APR 1984). This clause applies only if Seller is required to design, develop, or operate a system of records contemplated by this clause.

52.225-1 Buy American Act- Supplies (JUN 2003).

52.225-8 Duty-Free Entry (FEB 2000). This clause applies only if this contract identifies supplies to be afforded duty-free entry or if foreign supplies in excess of \$10,000 may be imported into the customs territory of the United States. For the purposes of this clause, the blanks in paragraph (g)(3) are completed as follows: UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT, DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE, Duty-free entry is claimed pursuant Section XXII, Chapter 98, Subchapter VIII, Item No. 9808.00.30 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States. Upon arrival of shipment at port of entry, the importer or authorized agent will notify Commander, Defense Contract Management Area Operations (DCMAO, New York, 201 Varick Street, New York, New York, 10014-4811, Attention DCRN-NCT) for execution of Customs Forms 7501, 7501-A, or 7506 and required duty free entry certificates.

52.225-13 Restrictions on Certain Foreign Purchases (MAR 2005).

52.227-1 Authorization and Consent (JUL 1995).

52.227-10 Filing of Patent Applications - Classified Subject Matter (APR 1984). This clause applies only if this contract will involve access to classified information.

52.227-14 Rights in Data--General Basic (JUN 1987), Alternate II (JUN 1987), Alternate III (JUN 1987) . This clause applies only if data will be produced, furnished or acquired under this contract.

52.227-16 Additional Data Requirements (JUN 1987). This clause applies only if this contract involves experimental, developmental, research, or demonstration work.

52.230-6 Administration of Cost Accounting Standards (APR 2005). Add "Buyer and the" before "CFAO" in paragraph (m). This clause applies if clause H001, H002, or H004 is included in this contract.

52.244-6 Subcontracts for Commercial Items (FEB 2006).

52.247-63 Preference for U.S.-Flag Air Carriers (JUN 2003). This clause only applies if this contract involves international air transportation.

52.247-64 Preference for Privately-Owned U.S. Flag Commercial Vessels (Feb 2006) & Alternate I (Apr 2003) (FEB 2006).

2. Commercial Items If goods or services being procured under this contract are commercial items and Clause H203 is set forth in the purchase order, the foregoing Government clauses in Sections 1 and 2 above are deleted and the following FAR/DFARS clauses are inserted in lieu thereof:

52.203-15 Whistleblower Protections Under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (MAR 2009).

52.209-6 Protecting the Government's Interests When Subcontracting With Contractors Debarred, Suspended or Proposed for Debarment (JAN 2005). Seller agrees it is not debarred, suspended, or proposed for debarment by the Federal Government. Seller shall disclose to Buyer, in writing, whether as of the time of award of this contract, Seller or its principals, is or is not debarred, suspended, or proposed for debarment by the Federal Government.

52.219-8 Utilization of Small Business Concerns (MAY 2004).

52.222-26 Equal Opportunity (APR 2002).

52.222-35 Equal Opportunity for Special Disabled Veterans, Veterans of the Vietnam Era, and Other Eligible Veterans (DEC 2001). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$25,000.

52.222-36 Affirmative Action For Workers With Disabilities (JUN 1998). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$ 10,000.

52.222-39 Notification of Employee Rights Concerning Payment of Union Dues or Fees (DEC 2004).

52.222-41 Service Contract Act of 1965 (NOV 2007). This clause applies only if this contract is subject to the Act.

52.222-54 Employment Eligibility Verification (JAN 2009).

This clause applies to all subcontracts that (1) are for (i) commercial or noncommercial services (except for commercial services that are part of the purchase of a COTS item, or an item that would be a COTS item, but for minor modifications performed by the COTS provider and are normally provided for that COTS item), or (ii) construction; (2) has a value of more than \$3,000; and (3) includes work

performed in the United States.

52.244-6 Subcontracts for Commercial Items (FEB 2006).

52.247-64 Preference for Privately-Owned U.S. Flag Commercial Vessels (Feb 2006) & Alternate I (Apr 2003) (FEB 2006).
