CONSIDERATION FOR DEPARTURES FROM REQUIREMENTS

The parties recognize that departures (deviations/waivers) from technical baseline requirements may be necessary from time-to-time during the performance of this contract which will require government approval. It is further understood that such requests for deviation/waiver, if approved, may be subject to attendant consideration. Such consideration may be either a credit to the purchase contract price or additional contract effort. Examples of waiver/deviation requests which may require consideration are:

- (A) Part substitutions involving price differences between the required part and the substitute part.
- (B) Delivery of an item which falls short of the original contract requirements.
- (C) Departures from contract military specifications/standards that reduce the scope of the supplier's efforts.

Accordingly, the buyer reserves the right to an equitable adjustment in the price of this contract or other appropriate consideration for approval of any deviation/waiver submitted by the supplier in accordance with the requirements of this contract.
