Representations and Certifications

Bidder is advised that the Representations and Certifications article in 4001, Additional General Provisions (Fixed Price Goods/Services Contract); 4002, Additional General Provisions (Labor Hour/Time and Material Contract, Cost Reimbursement Under Government Contract, Contract Labor); 4003, Additional General Provisions (Fixed Price Goods/Services Contract); or 4004 (Labor Hour/Time and Material Contract, Cost Reimbursement Under Government Contract, Contract Labor), as applicable, incorporates required government representations and certifications. Bidder is also advised that by submitting a proposal in response to a solicitation incorporating 4001, 4002, 4003, or 4004 or by accepting a contract incorporating 4001, 4002, 4003, or 4004, it will be providing the required representations and certifications. If unable or unwilling to accept a contract that incorporates these representations and certifications exactly as written, Bidder is asked to provide a written statement, ideally as part of its proposal, specifying the representations and certifications that it is unable or unwilling to make.
