SUPPLIER QUALIFICATION SPECIAL CERTIFICATION
MMS DEPOT REPAIR/SPARES HARDWARE PROCUREMENT

This purchase order requires Seller to notify/acquire Buyer approvals if following conditions exist for this order. This purchase order also requires for Seller to certify and submit with each shipment a certificate that attests compliance to the requirements specified herein.

- 1) If Seller has relocated/moved to a new manufacturing location or has had any changes in design requirements, manufacturing processes/equipment, test, and inspection methods since the initial Boeing part qualification or re-qualification, as applicable – **BUYER NOTIFICATION IS REQUIRED.**
- 2) If Seller has had a break in production for more than 12 months and design or processes changes have occurred since and as a result of this break – **BUYER NOTIFICATION IS REQUIRED.**

Note: The 12-month break in production applies to any assembly sub-assembly, or part being delivered irrespective of qualification requirements of the item specification.

Seller's certification shall be per Seller's format and shall attest that:

- 1) Articles (Seller's or its subtier suppliers) being delivered to Buyer were manufactured, processed and inspected in same facility and to the same design requirements, manufacturing processes/equipment, test, and inspection methods as the initial qualification or re-qualification of the item(s) on order.
- 2) Articles being delivered are from production line where no breaks or production stop have occurred for at least 12 months and were produced using same design requirements, manufacturing, equipment, test, and inspection processes during the 12-months window.

When articles on order have been identified as not meeting the above requirements, Seller shall formally notify the Buyer for appropriate review and disposition. Notification shall occur prior to fabrication of the hardware.
