

BDS Terms and Conditions

Clause Number: Q219L

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NOTIFICATION / DISPOSITION OF NONCONFORMING MATERIAL – MD-1898

When Seller determines a nonconformance exists or is suspected to exist on goods and/or services already delivered to Buyer under this Contract, Seller shall notify Buyer's Authorized Procurement Representative and submit Buyer's Form MD-1898, "Request for Deviation/Waiver" with all required information within three (3) business days of when nonconformance was determined. However, if the nonconformance affects safety of flight or is mission critical; Seller shall immediately provide all available information.

When Seller identifies nonconforming condition(s) which affects fit, form, function, safety, weight, maintainability or appearance (where a factor), of goods or services not yet delivered under this Contract, Seller shall notify Buyer's Authorized Procurement Representative and submit Buyer's Form MD-1898, "Request for Deviation/Waiver" to request Buyer's disposition of any proposed "Repair" or "Use-As-Is" disposition, or similar disposition.

However, when Seller is requesting Buyer's disposition of any proposed "Repair" or "Use-As-Is" disposition, or similar disposition for goods or services not yet delivered and Seller is located in the seven county Southern California area (i.e., Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, San Diego, Santa Barbara and Ventura counties) and the 'Ship To' location is Boeing location of; Long Beach (CA), Macon (GA), or New Breed in Santa Fe Springs (CA), then Seller shall contact Buyer's local source inspector in lieu of submitting Form MD-1898.
