

BIDDER'S PLACE OF MANUFACTURE AND BUSINESS SIZE

Manufacture and Inspection Location

Bidder's proposal shall state the place of manufacture of the Goods (or performance of the Services) and, if subject to source inspection, the inspecting location of the Goods if different than the manufacturing location. The inspecting location is a Bidder's facility where the final deliverable on the Purchase Contract is inspected as a finished product that is to be certified and provided to Buyer. If manufacturing, performing, or subcontracting outside the United States, the Bidder shall indicate its country of incorporation and whether the Bidder is a subsidiary of a U.S. entity.

Business Size

Bidder's proposal shall state the number of employees of Bidder and whether Bidder is a large or small business pursuant to the rules of the Small Business Administration.

The Bidder is hereby notified that, under 15 U.S.C. 645(d), any person who misrepresents a firm's business size or socioeconomic status as defined in FAR 52.219-9 in order to obtain a contract to be awarded under the preference programs established pursuant to sections 8(a), 8(d), 9 or 15 of the Small Business Act or any other provision of Federal law that specifically references section 8(d) for a definition of program eligibility, shall:

- a. Be punished by imposition of a fine, imprisonment, or both;
- b. Be subject to administrative remedies, including suspension and debarment; and
- c. Be ineligible for participation in programs conducted under the authority of the Act.
