FLYSHEET AN-22 INCIDENTS INVOLVING HARDWARE

The following procedure will be used whenever government hardware at the Seller's facility is damaged, lost, destroyed or stolen:

As soon as an incident is discovered, immediately (within 24 hours) notify the Buyer who will in turn make proper notification to Boeing Program Management and the Principle Contracting Officer. Such notification to the Buyer will include:

- 1. The identity/description of the lost, destroyed and/or damaged Government property.
- 2. The time and origin of the loss, destruction or damage.
- 3. All known interests in commingled property of which government property is a part.
- 4. The insurance, if any, covering any part of or interest in such commingled property.

Note: Seller is required to either repair or renovate the damaged property or take such actions as the Buyer directs. However, repairs to Government hardware should not be undertaken prior to Buyer direction.
